What is Volunteer Cabernet Sauvignon?



What does it taste like?

The 2015 Volunteer Cabernet Sauvignon is rich and deep in color, complemented with lingering notes of black cherry, tobacco and cassis. Flavors of licorice and blackberry provide great structure and finish to the wine.



Why Volunteer?

Winemaker Tony Leonardini is a former volunteer firefighter in Napa Valley. Ask, and he will share stories about traveling the state to put out fires. Volunteer wine salutes that spirit of giving.



What happened in 2015?

The 2015 vintage was one of incredible quality but minimal yields. Several years of California drought led to less water for the vines during the growing season. This produced smaller grapes, resembling blueberries, giving the wine both intense color and flavor. This vintage promises a wine rich in color with fragrant aromas and extracted flavors.



What's in it?

Appellation: Napa Valley
Winemaker: Tony Leonardini
Vintage: 2015
Varietal: Cabernet 96%, and 2% each of Petit Sirah and Zinfandel
Alcohol: 14.9%
