What does it taste like?

The 2016 Volunteer Cabernet Sauvignon is rich and deep in color, complemented with lingering notes of black cherry, tobacco and cassis. Flavors of licorice and blackberry provide great structure and finish to the wine.

Appellation: Napa Valley
Winemaker: Tony Leonardini
Vintage: 2016
Varietal: 91% Cabernet, 3% each of Petite Sirah, Petit Verdot, and Merlot
Alcohol: 15.0%
