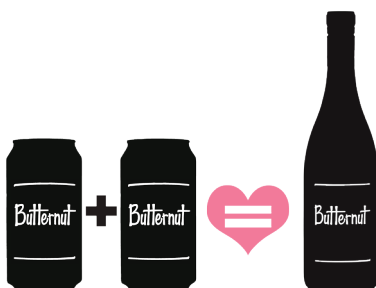
What's in it?
